Summary and other Accomplishments

Chi-Wing obtained her music trainings and qualifications in Hong Kong. After completing her grade 8 piano examinations (highest grade of ABRSM exam, UK), she moved on to learn pipe organ with Rev. Samuel Tong, Ms Wendy Tin-Lok Yuen and Ms Kin-Yu Wong. In 2005, Chi-Wing passed Grade 8 organ examination with distinction. After she moved to Calgary, she continues the organ study with Dr. Neil Cockburn. In 2015, Chi-Wing received the Kathleen Williams Prize for the highest marks nation-wide in the Service Playing Examination.

Chi-Wing has been actively involved in sacred music ministry at church for over 20 years in both Hong Kong and Calgary. She was the accompanist of children choir & ensemble, pianist of fellowship and Sunday Worship and the coordinator of Handbell Choir. She is now a church organist and pianist in Calgary.

She had worked in the Youth Department (teenagers who are 11-21 years old) of a church for 7 year before coming to Canada. As a mother of two children, Chi-Wing has extensive experience in working with children and teenagers.

Chi-Wing is now a part-time piano teacher, hoping to train children and teenagers in skills, and help them develop a life-long appreciation for music.
