

# COVID-19 PREVENTION PLAN POLICY

**Your Health and Safety is OUR PRIORITY. Please help us keep everyone safe.**

1. Face coverings have to be worn at all times by all attendees.

2. Please wash/ sanitize hands before and after class.

3. Do not enter if you have:

- Runny Nose
- Fever 38 Degrees or higher
- New Cough/ Sore Throat
- Difficulty breathing
- Been travelling or been in contact with someone with COVID-19

**\*\*If you have any of the above symptoms, please do not attend class in-studio and self-isolate for 14 days, or 10 days from the onset of symptoms, whichever is longer. Please use the AHS Online Assessment Tool to determine if further testing is recommended. Email/call the school to discuss options to get homework. \*\***

4. Health Check:

- Temperature checks or health checks questions may be conducted at the beginning of lesson.

5. Private Lessons:

- Are Non-parented, to minimize crowding in the reception area, parents are suggested to wait in the car.
- Students are suggested to come ONLY 5 minutes before their classes

6. Group Lessons:

- All classes will be assigned designated pianos to students. Parents and students will have to wear face coverings. Non-parented class can be a hybrid lesson style such as, 2 weeks online and 2 weeks' in-person class to avoid crowding in school.
- Students & Parents are suggested to come ONLY 5 minutes before their class
- Everyone must leave after their classes are done to maintain social distancing protocols.

7. Cleaning/Sanitizing of Pianos:

- Class time will have to allow for cleaning/ sanitizing of pianos and instruments.
- Students can help by sanitizing before/ after lesson.
- School has increased cleaning intervals.

**\*Classes may switch to Online in the case of AHS city mandate.\***

## Covid-19 Rapid Response Plan

If attendees show symptoms or test positive for Covid-19, staff may implement the following:

1. Immediately isolate the attendee from others

2. Clean Cleaning and disinfecting all surfaces that may have come into contact

3. Requiring hand hygiene and masking of the attendee.

4. Ensuring the attendee isolates as soon as possible.

5. Contact those that have possibly been exposed to the attendees
